2014 MID-YEAR STATS

Because of your faithful support, we together served more than 97,900 people during the first half of 2014!

- East Africa Nutritional Feeding Program: served 72,144 people, including 12,083 severely malnourished children, a total of 4,328,640 meals (335 tons)
- East Africa Medical Clinic: treated 17,893 patients
- East Africa Medical Clinic Spiritual Outreach Program: 1,236 salvations and rededications
- East Africa Pediatric Medical Center: purchased land, finalized design and budgets, and began preparations to build a new Pediatric Medical Center in an underserved region
- East Africa Refuge for Sex Trafficking Victims: 26 girls in the homes and 3 minors in community-based care at the end of the second quarter 2014
- East Africa Refuge Phase II: ended second quarter with 40 girls in phase two, living independently now but still benefitting from Refuge programs and services
- East Africa Mercy Chapel: 109 girls from red light district were attending Mercy Chapel Vocational Training Center at the end of the second quarter
- East Africa Children's Home for Girls: 23 girls in the home
- Saint Louis, MO, U.S.A. Love & Care Center / WINGS:
 - served 5,225 people, including 1,689 families, at weekly food distributions
 - served 270 children at Easter Eggstravaganza outreach
- Saint Louis, MO, U.S.A. Refuge for Sex Trafficking Victims in 2014:
 - 20 girls served (19 in the home including 4 minors and 1 community based client)
 - Average age of girls in the home: 20-years-old
 - 9 of the 20 were referred by law enforcement
 - Average number of days clients have stayed in the home: 113
 - 6 clients have stayed 3 or more months, and 5 of the 6 have stayed 6 or more months
 - 5 clients were reunited with family
- Human Trafficking Prevention Curriculum: provided the full curriculum to 10 schools, 32 organizations/churches and 6 individual families. Spoke to more than 1,200 people directly in human trafficking awareness events and trainings
